Longview, Washington (pop. 36,000) is located in Southwest Washington along the scenic Columbia River Basin nestled between Portland, OR and Seattle, WA. Position information: Responsible for performing formal supervisory duties for one or more Utility Systems crews that could include: evaluating employee performance; overseeing operations, repairs and replacements of the Utility Systems infrastructure; inspecting residential and commercial water and sewer connections; assisting the manager with planning and scheduling jobs; and preparing requisitions for necessary supplies and equipment.

Supervises staff, to include: prioritizing and assigning work; conducting performance evaluations; ensuring staff are trained; ensuring that employees follow policies and procedures; maintaining a healthy and safe working environment; and, making hiring, termination, and disciplinary recommendations.

Oversees repairs, replacements, and maintenance performed on water treatment and distribution and sewer collection components including mains, meters, valves, hydrants, pumps and lift stations, chemical storage and handling, and control systems; assists subordinates as needed.

Oversees programs such as cross connection control, distribution system sampling, hydrant flushing, and sewer pretreatment; ensures all facilities are operated and maintained in a safe and efficient manner; ensures that reports are generated and accurate.

Inspects residential water and sewer connections to ensure contractors are meeting city standards.

Minimum requirements: High School Diploma or GED; and 5-7 years of wastewater collection, water distribution, or water treatment operation and maintenance experience; and at least one year of leadership experience. Leadership experience may be demonstrated by employment responsibilities and/or non-work related responsibilities.
